Subject : Revocation of Permission -reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's Show Cause Notice No. 405/23/2007-FM/377 dated 08.06.2012 (copy enclosed) wherein your company was asked to show cause as to why action should not be initiated against your company under the provisions of the Clause 25.1.2 of Grant of Permission Agreement (GOPA) as your channels at Guwahati and Shillong have reportedly been non-operational for more than six months. However, no response has been received from your company in this regard despite expiry of prescribed period of reply mentioned in SCN.

2. Therefore, in pursuance of our show cause notice dated 08.06.2012, your company is liable for penal action under clause 25.1.2 of GOPA, which states "The Grantor may also revoke the permission if transmission from the Channel is discontinued for more than six months for whatever reason".

3. **Accordingly, permissions granted to your company to establish, maintain and operate the private FM radio Broadcasting Channels at Guwahati and Shillong are hereby revoked under Clause 25.1.2 of the GOPA.** Further, your attention is also drawn to the clause 25.3.5 of the GOPA, which states that "In the event of revocation of Permission, the Permission holder will lose the One Time Non-Refundable Entry Fee (OTEF). The Grantor shall not be responsible for an investment towards the operationalisation of the channel, not limited to capital and operating expenditure, in case of imposition of any sanction referred above".
