Subject: Revocation of Permission.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even no. dated 16.09.2009 wherein violation of terms and conditions of GOPA were brought to your notice, and you were advised to furnish the said amount along with documents. However, the default has not been not rectified. In fact it was further compounded by not resuming transmission of the channels despite Prasar Bharti permitting your company to enter the premises of Prasar Bharti at HPTV, DD, Ajmer and Jodhpur. As a result of which transmission from two channels allotted to your company at Ajmer and Jodhpur have not been in operation with effect from 24.03.2009.

2. In view of the above and considering that channels allotted to your company have been non-operational since 24.03.2009 and your company has put unacceptable terms, for starting channels, which are outside the scope of the Agreement, the permissions granted to you to establish, maintain and operate the FM radio broadcasting channels at Ajmer and Jodhpur are hereby revoked under clause 25.1.2 of Grant of Permission Agreement.
