NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 2024

GSR____.- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the (i) Photo Division, New Delhi (Group C and D Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1980 and (ii) Photo Division New Delhi (Production Assistant) Recruitment Rules, 1989, in so far they relate to the post of Photo and Video Journalist Grade I, Photo and Video Journalist Grade II, Multimedia Assistant Grade I & Multimedia Assistant Grade II, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Photo and Video Journalist Grade I, Photo and Video Journalist Grade II, Multimedia Assistant Grade I & Multimedia Assistant Grade II in the Photo Division of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Photo Division, Press Information Bureau, Photographic Cadre (Group-C), Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.- These rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.- The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix level attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns (2) to (4) of the said schedule.

4. Methods of recruitment, age-limit and qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification.- No person, -

- (a) who, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reason to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affects reservations, relaxation of age-limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Schedule Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special category of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
