Subject: Amendment of Recruitment Rules (RRs) for the posts of Clerk Grade-II, Group 'C' in Regional/Branch Offices of Press Information Bureau (PIB).


Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that Recruitment Rules for the posts of Clerk Grade-II, Group 'C' in Regional/Branch Offices of Press Information Bureau (PIB) are proposed to be amended to bring them in consonance with Model Recruitment Rules issued by DoP&T and 7th CPC recommendations. A draft of the notification in this regard is enclosed at Annexure.

2. DoP&T, vide its O.M. No. AB-14017/61/2008-Estt.(RR) dated 13.10.2015, has mentioned that before referring any proposal for framing/amendment in Recruitment Rules of any post in Ministries/Departments and their Subordinate and Attached Offices, the proposed amendments/revision in the Recruitment Rules would have to be put on the website of respective Ministries/Departments for 30 days for inviting comments from the stakeholders.

3. The stakeholders are requested to send their comments on the draft RRs for the said Group C post (enclosed) via e-mail at sopress.inb@nic.in within 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.

NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Press Information Bureau Regional and Branch Offices Class III (Non-Gazetted) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1989 except as respect things done before such suppression, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Clerk Grade-II, Group 'C' posts in Regional/Branch offices of Press Information Bureau, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement – (1) These rules may be called the Press Information Bureau (Regional/Branch Offices) Clerk Grade-II, Group 'C' posts Recruitment Rules, 2023.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application – These rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column-I the Scheduled annexed hereto.

3. Number of Post, classification and Level in Pay Matrix – The number of the said post, their classification and the Level in Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualification etc. – The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in column 5 to 13 of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Disqualification – No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Central Government, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving - Nothing in the rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
