

Corrigendum

Vide order dated 27.04.2019, the above appeal was decided. However, the Appellant has brought to the attention of the Tribunal that the decision in respect of Excision No. 8 has been directed to be reduced by 40 seconds. As the same is an inadvertent error, since the scene itself is stated to be of 35 seconds. The order dated 27.04.2019 in so far as it relates to excision No. 8 shall read as " the excision is reduced by 40%" instead of the " the excision is reduced by 40 seconds".
