NOTIFICATION

G.S.R.:-_____ in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the All India Radio (Chief Engineer (Civil) Level II) Recruitment Rules 1988, 1990 & 1995 and All India Radio, Civil Construction Wing (Group 'A' & 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules 1988, 1990 & 1995 except things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement: (1). These rules may be called the *All India Radio, Civil Construction Wing(Group 'A' & 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2019*.

(2). They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette or as specified in these Rules.

2. Number of posts, classification and Level in the pay matrix:- The number of said posts, their classification and the Level in the Pay Matrix scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc :- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specific in column 5 to 13 of the said schedule.

4. Liability to serve in the Defence Services:- Any person appointed to the post for which a degree in Engineering (or equivalent qualification) is the minimum qualification shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defense Service or post connected with the Defense of India, for a period of not less than four years including the period spent on training, if any; provided that such person:

- a). Shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of appointment.
- b). Shall not ordinarily be required to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of forty- five years.

5. Disqualifications:- No person –

- a). Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b). Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said post;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under Personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Savings:- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex- servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

8. Interpretation:- If any question relating to interpretation of these rules arises, it shall be decided by the Government.

9. Repeal:- The All India Radio, Civil Construction Wing (Group 'A' & 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules 1988,1990 &1995 in so far as they relate to posts to which these rules apply are hereby repealed.

Provided that such repeal shall not effect anything done or action taken under the said rules before such repeal.
