• Frequently asked Questions related to setting up of Community Radio Station.

Q 1: What is Community Radio Station?

Ans. 1: Community Radio Stations (CRS) is a low-power FM Radio Station having coverage in a range of 10 to 15Kms radius. The CRS can be set-up by eligible organizations such as "not-for profit" educational institutions, NGOs, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, ICAR institutions etc.

Q 2: Are there any guidelines for setting up CRS?

Ans. 2: The Government of India has laid the <u>Policy Guidelines for setting-up of Community Radio Station</u>. The Policy Guidelines are available on the website of the Ministry: <u>www.mib.gov.in</u>

Q 3: Can a CRS be established in any part of India?

Ans. 3: Yes. The CRS can be established in any part of India provided the frequency spot is available at that location.

Q 4: Who are not eligible to establish a community Radio Station?

Ans. 4: Individuals, political parties and their affiliate organizations, organizations operating with a motive to earn profit, organizations expressly banned by Union and State Governments are not eligible to run the Community Radio Stations.

Q 5: How Can I apply for the permission for setting up CRS?

Ans. 5: The permission for setting up a CRS can be obtained by eligible organizations by submitting <u>application forms</u> available on the website of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting www.mib.gov.in.

Q 6: How much Capital Investment is required to start a Community Radio Stations?

Ans. 6: For setting up of a CRS, an approximate cost of capital investment is Rs. 15 lakhs. However, the Capital cost depends upon the type of equipment installed at the CRS.

Q 7: There is a CRS in my locality/town/district can I also apply for CRS.

Ans 7: Yes, in a given area, maximum 5 nos. of Community Radio Stations can be operated.

Q 8: What are the steps in setting up of community Radio Stations?

Ans 8: The detailed steps in setting up of CRS are given here.

Q9: For how many years the permission is granted?

Ans 9: Initially, the permission for setting up of CRS is given for a period of 5 years. Later, the permission is extended for 5 years at a time.

Q10.: Is there any application fee for CRS application?

Ans 10: Yes, an amount of Rs. 2500 is required to be paid online through Bharat Kosh Portal: www.bharatkosh.gov.in
