1.It may be recalled that policy guidelines for downlinking of television channels were issued on

 $11.11.2005. \ The \ downlinking \ guidelines \ provide \ that, \ "No \ cable \ operator \ or \ DTH \ service \ provider \ shall, \ after \ the$

expiry of 180 days from the date of this notification, carry or include in his cable/DTH network any television $\frac{180}{100}$

channel that has not been registered under these guidelines". Amendments to this effect in the Cable Television

Network Rules 1994 and DTH guidelines are being notified separately. This notification will be issued on

11.5.2006.

2. However, a cable operator may continue to carry or include in his cable service any Television

broadcast or channel, which has made an application for registration to the Central Government on or

before the date of commencement of the notification, for a period of six months from the date of such

commencement or till such registration has been granted or refused, whichever is earlier. Further, in case of the channels uplinking from India, in accordance with permission for uplinking granted

before 2nd December 2005, they shall be treated as "registered" television channels and they can be

carried or included in the cable service.

3. The details of the 173 television channels permitted to uplink from India prior to 2.12.2005 are being

posted on Ministry's web-site http/: mib.nic.in.

4. The details of television channels uplinking from outside India, whose applications have been received

will also be placed on the web-site and up-dated from time to time.

5. The details of television channels uplinking from India after 2.12.2005 who have either been registered

or whose application for registration has been received will also be posted on the web -site.

6. All Cable Operators/ Head End Operators/MSO's/DTH Operators are requested to refer to the Ministry's

web-site for updated information.

7. This issues with the approval of the Secretary, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting.
